Artemis Place Society operates Artemis Place Secondary and Artemis Young Parent Program/Child Care Centre. The Secondary School integrates education, counselling and life-skills in a nurturing and intentional school community. Artemis Place is a program for young women and trans-identifying youth aged 15 to 19 years who face significant life challenges, weren't able to find success in other school settings, and/or who are pregnant or parenting.



Artemis Place Society



Artemis Place Society, a non-profit organization, has been delivering integrated educational services in the Capital Region since 1971. The Society offers an intentional community where learners come together to achieve their educational and personal goals. The core values of Compassion, Power and Respect are themes that are woven throughout programming.

Students have a primary Youth and Family Counsellor and Teacher who guide and support them in their goals and they are active participants in the school community.

Anyone can refer students to Artemis Place and the referral form is on the website. The program often has a waitlist but students are usually enrolled within one year. New students primarily begin in September although spaces sometimes come up during the school year.

Artemis Place Secondary

Artemis Place Secondary is a tuition-free, Special Education Independent School. Grades 10-12 are delivered through self-paced, personalized learning to meet each student's goals and needs. Curriculum is framed by an Individual Education Plan and increased project and inquiry-based learning is available.

In addition to required courses, other opportunities include Visual Arts, Drama, Foods and Nutrition, Fibers and Fabrics, Outdoor Education, Yoga, Environmental Science, Family Studies, Life skills and Career planning.

In the Counselling and Life-skills programming, each student works one to one with a Youth and Family Counsellor to set and attain goals. Skill-building workshops are offered on topics such as non-violent communication, budgeting, healthy relationships, mental wellness, gender diversity, and Indigenous ways of knowing.

Artemis Young Parent Program



Artemis Young Parent Program serves pregnant teens and young mothers in a nurturing community while also providing a safe, stimulating environment for their children. We have an on-site licensed infant/toddler centre where the staff of Early Childhood Educators provide responsive care for the children along with building respectful, trusting family relationships.

The program provides rich and varied experiences to support all aspects of children's well-being while nurturing their cultural and familial traditions. The program offers pre-natal and parenting education, individual and group counseling, support and advocacy. Parents are also given the opportunity to connect with other students to share the joys and challenges of parenthood.
